### Your Scripture for the Day

**Monday: Proverbs 16;17** The highway of the upright avoids evil; those who guard their ways preserve their lives. **18** Pride goes before destruction, a haughty spirit before a fall. **19** Better to be lowly in spirit along with the oppressed than to share plunder with the proud. **20** Whoever gives heed to instruction prospers, and blessed is the one who trusts in the Lord. - (NIV)

**Isaiah 13;11** "I, the Lord, will punish the world for its evil and the wicked for their sin. I will crush the arrogance of the proud and humble the pride of the mighty. - (NLT)

**Tuesday Job 23;10** But he knows the way that I take; when he has tested me, I will come forth as gold. **11** My feet have closely followed his steps; I have kept to his way without turning aside. **12** I have not departed from the commands of his lips; I have treasured the words of his mouth more than my daily bread. - (NIV84)

**Proverbs 27;21** The crucible for silver and the furnace for gold, but man is tested by the praise he receives. - (NIV84)

**Wednesday Matthew 24;37** "When the Son of Man returns, it will be like it was in Noah's day. **38** In those days before the flood, the people were enjoying banquets and parties and weddings right up to the time Noah entered his boat. **39** People didn't realize what was going to happen until the flood came and swept them all away. That is the way it will be when the Son of Man comes. - (NLT)

**Hosea 6;6** For I desire mercy, not sacrifice, and acknowledgment of God rather than burnt offerings. **7** Like Adam, they have broken the covenant—they were unfaithful to me there. - (NIV84)

**Thursday: Psalms 9;7** The Lord reigns forever; he has established his throne for judgment. **8** He will judge the world in righteousness; he will govern the peoples with justice. **9** The Lord is a refuge for the oppressed, a stronghold in times of trouble. **10** Those who know your name will trust in you, for you, Lord, have never forsaken those who seek you. - (NIV84)

**Habakkuk 2;3** For the revelation awaits an appointed time; it speaks of the end and will not prove false. Though it linger, wait for it; it will certainly come and will not delay. **4** "See, the enemy is puffed up; his desires are not upright—but the righteous person will live by his faithfulness— **5** indeed, wine betrays him; he is arrogant and never at rest. Because he is as greedy as the grave and like death is never satisfied, he gathers to himself all the nations and takes captive all the peoples. - (NIV)

**Friday: 2 Chronicles 32;22** That is how the Lord rescued Hezekiah and the people of Jerusalem from King Sennacherib of Assyria and from all the others who threatened them. So there was peace throughout the land. **23** From then on King Hezekiah became highly respected among all the surrounding nations, and many gifts for the Lord arrived at Jerusalem, with valuable presents for King Hezekiah, too. **24** About that time Hezekiah became deathly ill. He prayed to the Lord, who healed him and gave him a miraculous sign. **25** But Hezekiah did not respond appropriately to the kindness shown him, and he became proud. So the Lord's anger came against him and against Judah and Jerusalem. **26** Then Hezekiah humbled himself and repented of his pride, as did the people of Jerusalem. So the Lord's anger did not fall on them during Hezekiah's lifetime. - (NLT)

**Saturday: 2 Peter 2;5** And God did not spare the ancient world—except for Noah and the seven others in his family. Noah warned the world of God's righteous judgment. So God protected Noah when he destroyed the world of ungodly people with a vast flood. - (NLT)

**Hebrews 9;27** And just as each person is destined to die once and after that comes judgment, **28** so also Christ was offered once for all time as a sacrifice to take away the sins of many people. He will come again, not to deal with our sins, but to bring salvation to all who are eagerly waiting for him. - (NLT)
