**Your Scripture for the Day**

**Monday: Acts 16:6** Paul and his companions traveled throughout the region of Phrygia and Galatia, having been kept by the Holy Spirit from preaching the word in the province of Asia. **7** When they came to the border of Mysia, they tried to enter Bithynia, but the Spirit of Jesus would not allow them to. **8** So they passed by Mysia and went down to Troas. **9** During the night Paul had a vision of a man of Macedonia standing and begging him, "Come over to Macedonia and help us." **10** After Paul had seen the vision, we got ready at once to leave for Macedonia, concluding that God had called us to preach the gospel to them. - (NIV)

**Tuesday John 20:24** Now Thomas (also known as Didymus), one of the Twelve, was not with the disciples when Jesus came. **25** So the other disciples told him, "We have seen the Lord!" But he said to them, "Unless I see the nail marks in his hands and put my finger where the nails were, and put my hand into his side, I will not believe." **26** A week later his disciples were in the house again, and Thomas was with them. Though the doors were locked, Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you!" **27** Then he said to Thomas, "Put your finger here; see my hands. Reach out your hand and put it into my side. Stop doubting and believe." **28** Thomas said to him, "My Lord and my God!" **29** Then Jesus told him, "Because you have seen me, you have believed; blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed." - (NIV)

**Wednesday Luke 8:40** Now when Jesus returned, a crowd welcomed him, for they were all expecting him. **41** Then a man named Jairus, a synagogue leader, came and fell at Jesus' feet, pleading with him to come to his house **42** because his only daughter, a girl of about twelve, was dying. As Jesus was on his way, the crowds almost crushed him. - (NIV)

**Thursday: Luke 8:49** While Jesus was still speaking, someone came from the house of Jairus, the synagogue leader. "Your daughter is dead," he said. "Don't bother the teacher anymore." **50** Hearing this, Jesus said to Jairus, "Don't be afraid; just believe, and she will be healed." **51** When he arrived at the house of Jairus, he did not let anyone go in with him except Peter, John and James, and the child's father and mother. **52** Meanwhile, all the people were wailing and mourning for her. "Stop wailing," Jesus said. "She is not dead but asleep." **53** They laughed at him, knowing that she was dead. **54** But he took her by the hand and said, "My child, get up!" **55** Her spirit returned, and at once she stood up. Then Jesus told them to give her something to eat. **56** Her parents were astonished, but he ordered them not to tell anyone what had happened. - (NIV)

**Friday: Job 12:7** "But ask the animals, and they will teach you, or the birds in the sky, and they will tell you; **8** or speak to the earth, and it will teach you, or let the fish in the sea inform you. **9** Which of all these does not know that the hand of the Lord has done this? **10** In his hand is the life of every creature and the breath of all mankind. **11** Does not the ear test words as the tongue tastes food? **12** Is not wisdom found among the aged? Does not long life bring understanding? **13** "To God belong wisdom and power; counsel and understanding are his. - (NIV)

**Saturday: Job 28:20** Where then does wisdom come from? Where does understanding dwell? **21** It is hidden from the eyes of every living thing, concealed even from the birds in the sky. **22** Destruction and Death say, "Only a rumor of it has reached our ears." **23** God understands the way to it and he alone knows where it dwells, **24** for he views the ends of the earth and sees everything under the heavens. **25** When he established the force of the wind and measured out the waters, **26** when he made a decree for the rain and a path for the thunderstorm, **27** then he looked at wisdom and appraised it; he confirmed it and tested it. **28** And he said to the human race, "The fear of the Lord—that is wisdom, and to shun evil is understanding." - (NIV)
