Your Scripture for the Day

Monday: Matthew 12:15 Aware of this, Jesus withdrew from that place. Many followed him, and he healed all their sick, **16** warning them not to tell who he was. **17** This was to fulfill what was spoken through the prophet Isaiah: **18** "Here is my servant whom I have chosen, the one I love, in whom I delight; I will put my Spirit on him, and he will proclaim justice to the nations. **19** He will not quarrel or cry out; no one will hear his voice in the streets. **20** A bruised reed he will not break, and a smoldering wick he will not snuff out, till he leads justice to victory. **21** In his name the nations will put their hope." - (NIV84)

Tuesday John 16:12 "I have much more to say to you, more than you can now bear. **13** But when he, the Spirit of truth, comes, he will guide you into all truth. He will not speak on his own; he will speak only what he hears, and he will tell you what is yet to come. **14** He will bring glory to me by taking from what is mine and making it known to you. **15** All that belongs to the Father is mine. That is why I said the Spirit will take from what is mine and make it known to you." - (NIV84)

Colossians 2:11 In him you were also circumcised, in the putting off of the sinful nature, not with a circumcision done by the hands of men but with the circumcision done by Christ, - (NIV84)

Wednesday Joshua 5:6 The Israelites had moved about in the desert forty years until all the men who were of military age when they left Egypt had died, since they had not obeyed the Lord. For the Lord had sworn to them that they would not see the land that he had solemnly promised their fathers to give us, a land flowing with milk and honey. **7** So he raised up their sons in their place, and these were the ones Joshua circumcised. They were still uncircumcised because they had not been circumcised on the way. **8** And after the whole nation had been circumcised, they remained where they were in camp until they were healed. **9** Then the Lord said to Joshua, "Today I have rolled away the reproach of Egypt from you." So the place has been called Gilgal to this day. - (NIV84)

Thursday: 2 Kings 2:19 The men of the city said to Elisha, "Look, our lord, this town is well situated, as you can see, but the water is bad and the land is unproductive." **20** "Bring me a new bowl," he said, "and put salt in it." So they brought it to him. **21** Then he went out to the spring and threw the salt into it, saying, "This is what the Lord says: 'I have healed this water. Never again will it cause death or make the land unproductive.'" **22** And the water has remained wholesome to this day, according to the word Elisha had spoken. - (NIV84)

Friday: Psalms 18:30 As for God, his way is perfect; the word of the Lord is flawless. He is a shield for all who take refuge in him. **31** For who is God besides the Lord? And who is the Rock except our God? **32** It is God who arms me with strength and makes my way perfect. - (NIV84)

Isaiah 40:6 A voice says, "Cry out." And I said, "What shall I cry?" "All men are like grass, and all their glory is like the flowers of the field. **7** The grass withers and the flowers fall, because the breath of the Lord blows on them. Surely the people are grass. **8** The grass withers and the flowers fall, but the word of our God stands forever." - (NIV84)

Saturday: Hebrews 4:11 Let us, therefore, make every effort to enter that rest, so that no one will fall by following their example of disobedience. **12** For the word of God is living and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart. **13** Nothing in all creation is hidden from God's sight. Everything is uncovered and laid bare before the eyes of him to whom we must give account. - (NIV84)

1 Peter 1:22 Now that you have purified yourselves by obeying the truth so that you have sincere love for your brothers, love one another deeply, from the heart. **23** For you have been born again, not of perishable seed, but of imperishable, through the living and enduring word of God. - (NIV84)
