**Your Scripture for the Day**

**Monday: Ephesians 3:20** Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us, **21** to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, for ever and ever! Amen. - (NIV84)

**Luke 1:80** And the child grew and became strong in spirit; and he lived in the desert until he appeared publicly to Israel. - (NIV84)

**Tuesday 2 Corinthians 4:16** Therefore we do not lose heart. Though outwardly we are wasting away, yet inwardly we are being renewed day by day. **17** For our light and momentary troubles are achieving for us an eternal glory that far outweighs them all. **18** So we fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen. For what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal. - (NIV84)

**Romans 7:21** So I find this law at work: When I want to do good, evil is right there with me. **22** For in my inner being I delight in God's law; **23** but I see another law at work in the members of my body, waging war against the law of my mind and making me a prisoner of the law of sin at work within my members. **24** What a wretched man I am! Who will rescue me from this body of death? **25** Thanks be to God—through Jesus Christ our Lord! So then, I myself in my mind am a slave to God's law, but in the sinful nature a slave to the law of sin. - (NIV84)

**Wednesday 1 Corinthians 6:18** Flee from sexual immorality. All other sins a man commits are outside his body, but he who sins sexually sins against his own body. **19** Do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own; **20** you were bought at a price. Therefore honor God with your body. - (NIV84)

**John 3:29** The bride belongs to the bridegroom. The friend who attends the bridegroom waits and listens for him, and is full of joy when he hears the bridegroom's voice. That joy is mine, and it is now complete. **30** He must become greater; I must become less. - (NIV84)

**Thursday: 1 Thessalonians 3:10** Night and day we pray most earnestly that we may see you again and supply what is lacking in your faith. - (NIV84)

**Colossians 2:6** So then, just as you received Christ Jesus as Lord, continue to live in him, **7** rooted and built up in him, strengthened in the faith as you were taught, and overflowing with thankfulness. **8** See to it that no one takes you captive through hollow and deceptive philosophy, which depends on human tradition and the basic principles of this world rather than on Christ. **9** For in Christ all the fullness of the Deity lives in bodily form, **10** and you have been given fullness in Christ, who is the head over every power and authority. - (NIV84)

**Friday: Matthew 5:46** If you love those who love you, what reward will you get? Are not even the tax collectors doing that? **47** And if you greet only your brothers, what are you doing more than others? Do not even pagans do that? **48** Be perfect, therefore, as your heavenly Father is perfect. - (NIV84)

**1 Peter 1:13** Therefore, prepare your minds for action; be self-controlled; set your hope fully on the grace to be given you when Jesus Christ is revealed. **14** As obedient children, do not conform to the evil desires you had when you lived in ignorance. **15** But just as he who called you is holy, so be holy in all you do; **16** for it is written: "Be holy, because I am holy." - (NIV84)

**Saturday: Romans 8:29** For those God foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the likeness of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brothers. **30** And those he predestined, he also called; those he called, he also justified; those he justified, he also glorified. **31** What, then, shall we say in response to this? If God is for us, who can be against us? **32** He who did not spare his own Son, but gave him up for us all—how will he not also, along with him, graciously give us all things? - (NIV84)
