Your Scripture for the Day

Monday: Isaiah 9:1 Nevertheless, there will be no more gloom for those who were in distress. In the past he humbled the land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali, but in the future he will honor Galilee of the Gentiles, by the way of the sea, along the Jordan— **2** The people walking in darkness have seen a great light; on those living in the land of the shadow of death a light has dawned. **3** You have enlarged the nation and increased their joy; they rejoice before you as people rejoice at the harvest, as men rejoice when dividing the plunder. - (NIV84)

Tuesday: Isaiah 60:1 Arise, shine; For your light has come! And the glory of the Lord is risen upon you. **2** For behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, And deep darkness the people; But the Lord will arise over you, And His glory will be seen upon you. **3** The Gentiles shall come to your light, And kings to the brightness of your rising. - (NKJV)

Wednesday: John 3:16 "For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. **17** For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him. **18** Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe stands condemned already because he has not believed in the name of God's one and only Son. **19** This is the verdict: Light has come into the world, but men loved darkness instead of light because their deeds were evil. **20** Everyone who does evil hates the light, and will not come into the light for fear that his deeds will be exposed. **21** But whoever lives by the truth comes into the light, so that it may be seen plainly that what he has done has been done through God." - (NIV84)

Thursday: 1 Peter 2:9 But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people belonging to God, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light. **10** Once you were not a people, but now you are the people of God; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy. **11** Dear friends, I urge you, as aliens and strangers in the world, to abstain from sinful desires, which war against your soul. **12** Live such good lives among the pagans that, though they accuse you of doing wrong, they may see your good deeds and glorify God on the day he visits us. - (NIV84)

Friday: Psalms 112:1 Praise the Lord. Blessed is the man who fears the Lord, who finds great delight in his commands. **2** His children will be mighty in the land; the generation of the upright will be blessed. **3** Wealth and riches are in his house, and his righteousness endures forever. **4** Even in darkness light dawns for the upright, for the gracious and compassionate and righteous man. **5** Good will come to him who is generous and lends freely, who conducts his affairs with justice. **6** Surely he will never be shaken; a righteous man will be remembered forever. **7** He will have no fear of bad news; his heart is steadfast, trusting in the Lord. **8** His heart is secure, he will have no fear; in the end he will look in triumph on his foes. **9** He has scattered abroad his gifts to the poor, his righteousness endures forever; his horn will be lifted high in honor. **10** The wicked man will see and be vexed, he will gnash his teeth and waste away; the longings of the wicked will come to nothing. - (NIV84)

Saturday: Psalms 139:3 You discern my going out and my lying down; you are familiar with all my ways. **4** Before a word is on my tongue you know it completely, O Lord. **5** You hem me in—behind and before; you have laid your hand upon me. **6** Such knowledge is too wonderful for me, too lofty for me to attain. **7** Where can I go from your Spirit? Where can I flee from your presence? **8** If I go up to the heavens, you are there; if I make my bed in the depths, you are there. **9** If I rise on the wings of the dawn, if I settle on the far side of the sea, **10** even there your hand will guide me, your right hand will hold me fast. **11** If I say, "Surely the darkness will hide me and the light become night around me," **12** even the darkness will not be dark to you; the night will shine like the day, for darkness is as light to you. - (NIV84)
