Luke 17:11 As Jesus continued on toward Jerusalem, he reached the border between Galilee and Samaria. **12** As he entered a village there, ten men with leprosy stood at a distance, **13** crying out, "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!" **14** He looked at them and said, "Go show yourselves to the priests." And as they went, they were cleansed of their leprosy. **15** One of them, when he saw that he was healed, came back to Jesus, shouting, "Praise God!" **16** He fell to the ground at Jesus' feet, thanking him for what he had done. This man was a Samaritan. **17** Jesus asked, "Didn't I heal ten men? Where are the other nine? **18** Has no one returned to give glory to God except this foreigner?" **19** And Jesus said to the man, "Stand up and go. Your faith has healed you." - (NLT)

Monday: Hebrews 10:35 So do not throw away this confident trust in the Lord. Remember the great reward it brings you! **36** Patient endurance is what you need now, so that you will continue to do God's will.
