Your Scripture for the Day

Monday: **Mark 4:35** That day when evening came, he said to his disciples, "Let us go over to the other side." **36** Leaving the crowd behind, they took him along, just as he was, in the boat. There were also other boats with him. **37** A furious squall came up, and the waves broke over the boat, so that it was nearly swamped. **38** Jesus was in the stern, sleeping on a cushion. The disciples woke him and said to him, "Teacher, don't you care if we drown?" **39** He got up, rebuked the wind and said to the waves, "Quiet! Be still!" Then the wind died down and it was completely calm. **40** He said to his disciples, "Why are you so afraid? Do you still have no faith?" **41** They were terrified and asked each other, "Who is this? Even the wind and the waves obey him!" - (NIV84)

Tuesday **Mark 1:21** Jesus and his companions went to the town of Capernaum. When the Sabbath day came, he went into the synagogue and began to teach. **22** The people were amazed at his teaching, for he taught with real authority—quite unlike the teachers of religious law. **23** Suddenly, a man in the synagogue who was possessed by an evil spirit cried out, **24** "Why are you interfering with us, Jesus of Nazareth? Have you come to destroy us? I know who you are—the Holy One of God!" **25** But Jesus reprimanded him. "Be quiet! Come out of the man," he ordered. **26** At that, the evil spirit screamed, threw the man into a convulsion, and then came out of him. **27** Amazement gripped the audience, and they began to discuss what had happened. "What sort of new teaching is this?" they asked excitedly. "It has such authority! Even evil spirits obey his orders!" - (NLT)

Wednesday **Matthew 9:2** Some men brought to him a paralytic, lying on a mat. When Jesus saw their faith, he said to the paralytic, "Take heart, son; your sins are forgiven." **3** At this, some of the teachers of the law said to themselves, "This fellow is blaspheming!" **4** Knowing their thoughts, Jesus said, "Why do you entertain evil thoughts in your hearts? **5** Which is easier: to say, 'Your sins are forgiven,' or to say, 'Get up and walk'? **6** But so that you may know that the Son of Man has authority on earth to forgive sins...." Then he said to the paralytic, "Get up, take your mat and go home." **7** And the man got up and went home. **8** When the crowd saw this, they were filled with awe; and they praised God, who had given such authority to men. - (NIV84)

Thursday: **Matthew 20:25** Jesus called them together and said, "You know that the rulers of the Gentiles lord it over them, and their high officials exercise authority over them. **26** Not so with you. Instead, whoever wants to become great among you must be your servant, **27** and whoever wants to be first must be your slave— **28** just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many." - (NIV84)

Galatians 4:7 So you are no longer a slave, but a son; and since you are a son, God has made you also an heir. - (NIV84)

Friday: **Mark 11:27** They arrived again in Jerusalem, and while Jesus was walking in the temple courts, the chief priests, the teachers of the law and the elders came to him. **28** "By what authority are you doing these things?" they asked. "And who gave you authority to do this?" **29** Jesus replied, "I will ask you one question. Answer me, and I will tell you by what authority I am doing these things. **30** John's baptism—was it from heaven, or from men? Tell me!" **31** They discussed it among themselves and said, "If we say, 'From heaven,' he will ask, 'Then why didn't you believe him?' **32** But if we say, 'From men'...." (They feared the people, for everyone held that John really was a prophet.) **33** So they answered Jesus, "We don't know." Jesus said, "Neither will I tell you by what authority I am doing these things." - (NIV84)

Saturday: **Mark 6:6** And he was amazed at their lack of faith. Then Jesus went around teaching from village to village. **7** Calling the Twelve to him, he sent them out two by two and gave them authority over evil spirits. - (NIV84)

Luke 10:17 The seventy-two returned with joy and said, "Lord, even the demons submit to us in your name." **18** He replied, "I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven. **19** I have given you authority to trample on snakes and scorpions and to overcome all the power of the enemy; nothing will harm you. **20** However, do not rejoice that the spirits submit to you, but rejoice that your names are written in heaven." - (NIV84)
