**Your Scripture for the Day**

**Monday: Genesis 3:23** So the LORD God banished them from the Garden of Eden, and he sent Adam out to cultivate the ground from which he had been made. **24** After sending them out, the Lord God stationed mighty cherubim to the east of the Garden of Eden. And he placed a flaming sword that flashed back and forth to guard the way to the tree of life. - (NLT)

**Tuesday: Colossians 2:2** My goal is that they may be encouraged in heart and united in love, so that they may have the full riches of complete understanding, in order that they may know the mystery of God, namely, Christ, **3** in whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge. - (NIV)

**1 Corinthians 2:6** We do, however, speak a message of wisdom among the mature, but not the wisdom of this age or of the rulers of this age, who are coming to nothing. **7** No, we declare God's wisdom, a mystery that has been hidden and that God destined for our glory before time began. - (NIV)

**James 1:16** Don't be deceived, my dear brothers and sisters. **17** Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights, who does not change like shifting shadows. **18** He chose to give us birth through the word of truth, that we might be a kind of firstfruits of all he created. - (NIV)

**Wednesday: Proverbs 6:20** My son, obey your father's commands, and don't neglect your mother's instruction. **21** Keep their words always in your heart. Tie them around your neck. **22** When you walk, their counsel will lead you. When you sleep, they will protect you. When you wake up, they will advise you. **23** For their command is a lamp and their instruction a light; their corrective discipline is the way to life. - (NLT)

**Thursday: Proverbs 5:3** For the lips of an immoral woman are as sweet as honey, and her mouth is smoother than oil. **4** But in the end she is as bitter as poison, as dangerous as a double-edged sword. **5** Her feet go down to death; her steps lead straight to the grave. **6** For she cares nothing about the path to life. She staggers down a crooked trail and doesn't realize it. - (NLT)

**Mark 8:34** Then, calling the crowd to join his disciples, he said, "If any of you wants to be my follower, you must give up your own way, take up your cross, and follow me. **35** If you try to hang on to your life, you will lose it. But if you give up your life for my sake and for the sake of the Good News, you will save it. **36** And what do you benefit if you gain the whole world but lose your own soul? **37** Is anything worth more than your soul? - (NLT)

**Friday: Proverbs 12:25** Worry weighs a person down; an encouraging word cheers a person up. **26** The godly give good advice to their friends; the wicked lead them astray. **27** Lazy people don't even cook the game they catch, but the diligent make use of everything they find. **28** The way of the godly leads to life; that path does not lead to death. - (NLT)

**Hebrews 10:19** And so, dear brothers and sisters, we can boldly enter heaven's Most Holy Place because of the blood of Jesus. **20** By his death, Jesus opened a new and life-giving way through the curtain into the Most Holy Place. **21** And since we have a great High Priest who rules over God's house, **22** let us go right into the presence of God with sincere hearts fully trusting him. For our guilty consciences have been sprinkled with Christ's blood to make us clean, and our bodies have been washed with pure water. - (NLT)

**Saturday: Galatians 1:13** For you have heard of my previous way of life in Judaism, how intensely I persecuted the church of God and tried to destroy it. **14** I was advancing in Judaism beyond many of my own age among my people and was extremely zealous for the traditions of my fathers. **15** But when God, who set me apart from my mother's womb and called me by his grace, was pleased **16** to reveal his Son in me so that I might preach him among the Gentiles, my immediate response was not to consult any human being. **17** I did not go up to Jerusalem to see those who were apostles before I was, but I went into Arabia. Later I returned to Damascus. - (NIV)
