He performs countless miracles. 11 "Yet when he comes near, I cannot see him. When he moves by, I do not see him go. - (NLT)
- Proverbs 8:22 "The Lord formed me from the beginning, before he created anything Wednesday else. 23 I was appointed in ages past, at the very first, before the earth began. 24 I was born before the oceans were created, before the springs bubbled forth their waters. 25 Before the mountains were formed, before the hills, I was born- 26 before he had made the earth and fields and the first handfuls of soil. 27 I was there when he established the heavens, when he drew the horizon on the oceans. **28** I was there when he set the clouds above, when he established springs deep in the earth. 29 I was there when he set the limits of the seas, so they would not spread beyond their boundaries.
