Your Scripture for the Day

Monday: **John 6:25** When they found him on the other side of the lake, they asked him, "Rabbi, when did you get here?" **26** Jesus answered, "I tell you the truth, you are looking for me, not because you saw miraculous signs but because you ate the loaves and had your fill. **27** Do not work for food that spoils, but for food that endures to eternal life, which the Son of Man will give you. On him God the Father has placed his seal of approval." - (NIV84)

Tuesday **John 6:32** Jesus said to them, "I tell you the truth, it is not Moses who has given you the bread from heaven, but it is my Father who gives you the true bread from heaven. **33** For the bread of God is he who comes down from heaven and gives life to the world." **34** "Sir," they said, "from now on give us this bread." **35** Then Jesus declared, "I am the bread of life. He who comes to me will never go hungry, and he who believes in me will never be thirsty. **36** But as I told you, you have seen me and still you do not believe. **37** All that the Father gives me will come to me, and whoever comes to me I will never drive away. **38** For I have come down from heaven not to do my will but to do the will of him who sent me. **39** And this is the will of him who sent me, that I shall lose none of all that he has given me, but raise them up at the last day. **40** For my Father's will is that everyone who looks to the Son and believes in him shall have eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day." - (NIV84)

Wednesday **John 6:44** "No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws him, and I will raise him up at the last day. **45** It is written in the Prophets: 'They will all be taught by God.' Everyone who listens to the Father and learns from him comes to me. **46** No one has seen the Father except the one who is from God; only he has seen the Father. - (NIV84)

Thursday: **Matthew 6:9** "This, then, is how you should pray: " 'Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, **10** your kingdom come, your will be done on earth as it is in heaven. **11** Give us today our daily bread. **12** Forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. **13** And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one.' - (NIV84)

Ephesians 5:19 Speak to one another with psalms, hymns and spiritual songs. Sing and make music in your heart to the Lord, **20** always giving thanks to God the Father for everything, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. **21** Submit to one another out of reverence for Christ. - (NIV84)

Friday: **Deuteronomy 32:6** Is this the way you repay the Lord, O foolish and unwise people? Is he not your Father, your Creator, who made you and formed you? **7** Remember the days of old; consider the generations long past. Ask your father and he will tell you, your elders, and they will explain to you. **8** When the Most High gave the nations their inheritance, when he divided all mankind, he set up boundaries for the peoples according to the number of the sons of Israel. **9** For the Lord's portion is his people, Jacob his allotted inheritance. - (NIV84)

Saturday: **1 Corinthians 15:22** For as in Adam all die, so in Christ all will be made alive. **23** But each in his own turn: Christ, the firstfruits; then, when he comes, those who belong to him. **24** Then the end will come, when he hands over the kingdom to God the Father after he has destroyed all dominion, authority and power. **25** For he must reign until he has put all his enemies under his feet. **26** The last enemy to be destroyed is death. **27** For he "has put everything under his feet." Now when it says that "everything" has been put under him, it is clear that this does not include God himself, who put everything under Christ. **28** When he has done this, then the Son himself will be made subject to him who put everything under him, so that God may be all in all. - (NIV84)
