Your Scripture for the Day

Monday: **Matthew 5:43** "You have heard the law that says, 'Love your neighbor' and hate your enemy. **44** But I say, love your enemies! Pray for those who persecute you! **45** In that way, you will be acting as true children of your Father in heaven. For he gives his sunlight to both the evil and the good, and he sends rain on the just and the unjust alike. **46** If you love only those who love you, what reward is there for that? Even corrupt tax collectors do that much. **47** If you are kind only to your friends, how are you different from anyone else? Even pagans do that. **48** But you are to be perfect, even as your Father in heaven is perfect. - (NLT)

Tuesday **Colossians 1:28** We proclaim him, admonishing and teaching everyone with all wisdom, so that we may present everyone perfect in Christ. - (NIV84)

Colossians 3:12 Since God chose you to be the holy people he loves, you must clothe yourselves with tenderhearted mercy, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience. **13** Make allowance for each other's faults, and forgive anyone who offends you. Remember, the Lord forgave you, so you must forgive others. **14** Above all, clothe yourselves with love, which binds us all together in perfect harmony. - (NLT)

Wednesday **Isaiah 26:1** In that day this song will be sung in the land of Judah: We have a strong city; God makes salvation its walls and ramparts. **2** Open the gates that the righteous nation may enter, the nation that keeps faith. **3** You will keep in perfect peace him whose mind is steadfast, because he trusts in you. **4** Trust in the Lord forever, for the Lord, the Lord, is the Rock eternal. - (NIV84)

Deuteronomy 32:4 He is the Rock; his deeds are perfect. Everything he does is just and fair. He is a faithful God who does no wrong; how just and upright he is! - (NLT)

Thursday: **Psalms 19:7** The instructions of the Lord are perfect, reviving the soul. The decrees of the Lord are trustworthy, making wise the simple. **8** The commandments of the Lord are right, bringing joy to the heart. The commands of the Lord are clear, giving insight for living. **9** Reverence for the Lord is pure, lasting forever. The laws of the Lord are true; each one is fair. **10** They are more desirable than gold, even the finest gold. They are sweeter than honey, even honey dripping from the comb. **11** They are a warning to your servant, a great reward for those who obey them. - (NLT)

Friday: **Hebrews 11:32** How much more do I need to say? It would take too long to recount the stories of the faith of Gideon, Barak, Samson, Jephthah, David, Samuel, and all the prophets. **33** By faith these people overthrew kingdoms, ruled with justice, and received what God had promised them. They shut the mouths of lions, **34** quenched the flames of fire, and escaped death by the edge of the sword. Their weakness was turned to strength. They became strong in battle and put whole armies to flight. **35** Women received their loved ones back again from death. But others were tortured, refusing to turn from God in order to be set free. They placed their hope in a better life after the resurrection. - (NLT)

Hebrews 11:39 All these people earned a good reputation because of their faith, yet none of them received all that God had promised. **40** For God had something better in mind for us, so that they would not reach perfection without us. - (NLT)

Saturday: **Matthew 19:16** Someone came to Jesus with this question: "Teacher, what good deed must I do to have eternal life?" **17** "Why ask me about what is good?" Jesus replied. "There is only One who is good. But to answer your question—if you want to receive eternal life, keep the commandments." **18** "Which ones?" the man asked. And Jesus replied: " 'You must not murder. You must not commit adultery. You must not steal. You must not testify falsely. **19** Honor your father and mother. Love your neighbor as yourself.' " **20** "I've obeyed all these commandments," the young man replied. "What else must I do?" **21** Jesus told him, "If you want to be perfect, go and sell all your possessions and give the money to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven. Then come, follow me." **22** But when the young man heard this, he went away sad, for he had many possessions. - (NLT)
