## Your Scripture for the Day

**Monday:** **Luke 19:12** He said, "A nobleman was called away to a distant empire to be crowned king and then return. **13** Before he left, he called together ten of his servants and divided among them ten pounds of silver, saying, 'Invest this for me while I am gone.' - (NLT)

**Luke 19:24** "Then, turning to the others standing nearby, the king ordered, 'Take the money from this servant, and give it to the one who has ten pounds.' **25** " 'But, master,' they said, 'he already has ten pounds!' **26** " 'Yes,' the king replied, 'and to those who use well what they are given, even more will be given. But from those who do nothing, even what little they have will be taken away.'" - (NLT)

**Tuesday** **Colossians 3:16** Let the message about Christ, in all its richness, fill your lives. Teach and counsel each other with all the wisdom he gives. Sing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs to God with thankful hearts. **17** And whatever you do or say, do it as a representative of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks through him to God the Father.
