Your Scripture for the Day

Monday: Ephesians 1:9 God has now revealed to us his mysterious plan regarding Christ, a plan to fulfill his own good pleasure. **10** And this is the plan: At the right time he will bring everything together under the authority of Christ—everything in heaven and on earth. **11** Furthermore, because we are united with Christ, we have received an inheritance from God, for he chose us in advance, and he makes everything work out according to his plan. - (NLT)

Tuesday 2 Timothy 1:9 For God saved us and called us to live a holy life. He did this, not because we deserved it, but because that was his plan from before the beginning of time—to show us his grace through Christ Jesus. - (NLT)

Isaiah 14:26 This is the plan determined for the whole world; this is the hand stretched out over all nations. **27** For the Lord Almighty has purposed, and who can thwart him? His hand is stretched out, and who can turn it back? - (NIV84)

Wednesday Job 42:1 Then Job replied to the Lord: **2** "I know that you can do all things; no plan of yours can be thwarted. **3** You asked, 'Who is this that obscures my counsel without knowledge?' Surely I spoke of things I did not understand, things too wonderful for me to know. **4** "You said, 'Listen now, and I will speak; I will question you, and you shall answer me.' **5** My ears had heard of you but now my eyes have seen you. - (NIV84)

Thursday: Genesis 11:3 They began saying to each other, "Let's make bricks and harden them with fire." (In this region bricks were used instead of stone, and tar was used for mortar.) **4** Then they said, "Come, let's build a great city for ourselves with a tower that reaches into the sky. This will make us famous and keep us from being scattered all over the world." **5** But the Lord came down to look at the city and the tower the people were building. **6** "Look!" he said. "The people are united, and they all speak the same language. After this, nothing they set out to do will be impossible for them! **7** Come, let's go down and confuse the people with different languages. Then they won't be able to understand each other." **8** In that way, the Lord scattered them all over the world, and they stopped building the city. **9** That is why the city was called Babel, because that is where the Lord confused the people with different languages. In this way he scattered them all over the world. - (NLT)

Friday: Genesis 41:33 "Therefore, Pharaoh should find an intelligent and wise man and put him in charge of the entire land of Egypt. **34** Then Pharaoh should appoint supervisors over the land and let them collect one-fifth of all the crops during the seven good years. **35** Have them gather all the food produced in the good years that are just ahead and bring it to Pharaoh's storehouses. Store it away, and guard it so there will be food in the cities. **36** That way there will be enough to eat when the seven years of famine come to the land of Egypt. Otherwise this famine will destroy the land." **37** Joseph's suggestions were well received by Pharaoh and his officials. **38** So Pharaoh asked his officials, "Can we find anyone else like this man so obviously filled with the spirit of God?" **39** Then Pharaoh said to Joseph, "Since God has revealed the meaning of the dreams to you, clearly no one else is as intelligent or wise as you are. **40** You will be in charge of my court, and all my people will take orders from you. Only I, sitting on my throne, will have a rank higher than yours." - (NLT)

Saturday: Proverbs 14:22 Do not those who plot evil go astray? But those who plan what is good find love and faithfulness. - (NIV84)

Proverbs 21:29 A wicked man puts up a bold front, but an upright man gives thought to his ways. **30** There is no wisdom, no insight, no plan that can succeed against the Lord. **31** The horse is made ready for the day of battle, but victory rests with the Lord. - (NIV84)
