Your Scripture for the Day

Monday: 2 Chronicles 14:7 Therefore he said to Judah, "Let us build these cities and make walls around *them*, and towers, gates, and bars, *while* the land *is* yet before us, because we have sought the Lord our God; we have sought *Him*, and He has given us rest on every side." So they built and prospered. **8** And Asa had an army of three hundred thousand from Judah who carried shields and spears, and from Benjamin two hundred and eighty thousand men who carried shields and drew bows; all these *were* mighty men of valor. **9** Then Zerah the Ethiopian came out against them with an army of a million men and three hundred chariots, and he came to Mareshah. **10** So Asa went out against him, and they set the troops in battle array in the Valley of Zephathah at Mareshah. **11** And Asa cried out to the Lord his God, and said, "Lord, *it is* nothing for You to help, whether with many or with those who have no power; help us, O Lord our God, for we rest on You, and in Your name we go against this multitude. O Lord, You *are* our God; do not let man prevail against You!" **12** So the Lord struck the Ethiopians before Asa and Judah, and the Ethiopians fled. - (NKJV)

Tuesday 2 Chronicles 15:1 Now the Spirit of God came upon Azariah the son of Oded. **2** And he went out to meet Asa, and said to him: "Hear me, Asa, and all Judah and Benjamin. The Lord *is* with you while you are with Him. If you seek Him, He will be found by you; but if you forsake Him, He will forsake you. **3** For a long time Israel *has been* without the true God, without a teaching priest, and without law; **4** but when in their trouble they turned to the Lord God of Israel, and sought Him, He was found by them. **5** And in those times *there* was no peace to the one who went out, nor to the one who came in, but great turmoil was on all the inhabitants of the lands. **6** So nation was destroyed by nation, and city by city, for God troubled them with every adversity. **7** But you, be strong and do not let your hands be weak, for your work shall be rewarded!". - (NKJV)

Wednesday Acts 2:42 And they continued steadfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, in the breaking of bread, and in prayers. **43** Then fear came upon every soul, and many wonders and signs were done through the apostles. - (NKJV)

Exodus 14:13 And Moses said to the people, "Do not be afraid. Stand still, and see the salvation of the Lord, which He will accomplish for you today. For the Egyptians whom you see today, you shall see again no more forever. - (NKJV)

Thursday: 2 Kings 6:8 Now the king of Syria was making war against Israel; and he consulted with his servants, saying, "My camp *will be* in such and such a place." **15** And when the servant of the man of God arose early and went out, there was an army, surrounding the city with horses and chariots. And his servant said to him, "Alas, my master! What shall we do?" **16** So he answered, "Do not fear, for those who *are* with us *are* more than those who *are* with them." **17** And Elisha prayed, and said, "Lord, I pray, open his eyes that he may see." Then the Lord opened the eyes of the young man, and he saw. And behold, the mountain was full of horses and chariots of fire all around Elisha. **18** So when *the Syrians* came down to him, Elisha prayed to the Lord, and said, "Strike this people, I pray, with blindness." And He struck them with blindness according to the word of Elisha. - (NKJV)

Friday: Luke 12:15 And He said to them, "**Take heed and beware of covetousness, for one's life does not consist in the abundance of the things he possesses.**" **16** Then He spoke a parable to them, saying: "**The ground of a certain rich man yielded plentifully.** **17** And he thought within himself, saying, 'What shall I do, since I have no room to store my crops?' **18** So he said, 'I will do this: I will pull down my barns and build greater, and there I will store all my crops and my goods. **19** And I will say to my soul, 'Soul, you have many goods laid up for many years; take your ease; eat, drink, *and* be merry.'" **20** But God said to him, "Fool! This night your soul will be required of you; then whose will those things be which you have provided?" **21** "**So is he who lays up treasure for himself, and is not rich toward God.**" - (NKJV)
