Your Scripture for the Day

Monday: James 3:2 Indeed, we all make many mistakes. For if we could control our tongues, we would be perfect and could also control ourselves in every other way. **3** We can make a large horse go wherever we want by means of a small bit in its mouth. **4** And a small rudder makes a huge ship turn wherever the pilot chooses to go, even though the winds are strong. **5** In the same way, the tongue is a small thing that makes grand speeches. But a tiny spark can set a great forest on fire. **6** And among all the parts of the body, the tongue is a flame of fire. It is a whole world of wickedness, corrupting your entire body. It can set your whole life on fire, for it is set on fire by hell itself. - (NLT)

Tuesday 1 Peter 3:8 Finally, all of you should be of one mind. Sympathize with each other. Love each other as brothers and sisters. Be tenderhearted, and keep a humble attitude. **9** Don't repay evil for evil. Don't retaliate with insults when people insult you. Instead, pay them back with a blessing. That is what God has called you to do, and he will grant you his blessing. **10** For the Scriptures say, "If you want to enjoy life and see many happy days, keep your tongue from speaking evil and your lips from telling lies. **11** Turn away from evil and do good. Search for peace, and work to maintain it. **12** The eyes of the Lord watch over those who do right, and his ears are open to their prayers. But the Lord turns his face against those who do evil." - (NLT)

Wednesday Deuteronomy 32:45 When Moses had finished reciting all these words to the people of Israel, **46** he added: "Take to heart all the words of warning I have given you today. Pass them on as a command to your children so they will obey every word of these instructions. **47** These instructions are not empty words—they are your life! By obeying them you will enjoy a long life in the land you will occupy when you cross the Jordan River." - (NLT)

Thursday: John 6:63 The Spirit alone gives eternal life. Human effort accomplishes nothing. And the very words I have spoken to you are spirit and life. - (NLT)

Proverbs 18: 21 The tongue can bring death or life; those who love to talk will reap the consequences. - (NLT)

Proverbs 12:18 The words of the reckless pierce like swords, but the tongue of the wise brings healing. - (NIV)

Friday: 2 Chronicles 34:26 Tell the king of Judah, who sent you to inquire of the Lord, 'This is what the Lord, the God of Israel, says concerning the words you heard: **27** Because your heart was responsive and you humbled yourself before God when you heard what he spoke against this place and its people, and because you humbled yourself before me and tore your robes and wept in my presence, I have heard you, declares the Lord. **28** Now I will gather you to your fathers, and you will be buried in peace. Your eyes will not see all the disaster I am going to bring on this place and on those who live here.' So they took her answer back to the king. - (NIV84)

Saturday: Numbers 14:1 Then the whole community began weeping aloud, and they cried all night. **2** Their voices rose in a great chorus of protest against Moses and Aaron. "If only we had died in Egypt, or even here in the wilderness!" they complained. - (NLT)

Numbers 14:26 Then the Lord said to Moses and Aaron, **27** "How long must I put up with this wicked community and its complaints about me? Yes, I have heard the complaints the Israelites are making against me. **28** Now tell them this: 'As surely as I live, declares the Lord, I will do to you the very things I heard you say. **29** You will all drop dead in this wilderness! Because you complained against me, every one of you who is twenty years old or older and was included in the registration will die. **30** You will not enter and occupy the land I swore to give you. The only exceptions will be Caleb son of Jephunneh and Joshua son of Nun. **31** " "You said your children would be carried off as plunder. Well, I will bring them safely into the land, and they will enjoy what you have despised. **32** But as for you, you will drop dead in this wilderness. - (NLT)
