YOUR SCRIPTURE FOR THE DAY

Monday: Numbers 24:1 Now when Balaam saw that it pleased the Lord to bless Israel, he did not resort to sorcery as at other times, but turned his face toward the desert. **2** When Balaam looked out and saw Israel encamped tribe by tribe, the Spirit of God came upon him **3** and he uttered his oracle: "The oracle of Balaam son of Beor, the oracle of one whose eye sees clearly, **4** the oracle of one who hears the words of God, who sees a vision from the Almighty, who falls prostrate, and whose eyes are opened:

Tuesday Numbers 24:5 "How beautiful are your tents, O Jacob, your dwelling places, O Israel! **6** "Like valleys they spread out, like gardens beside a river, like aloes planted by the Lord, like cedars beside the waters. **7** Water will flow from their buckets; their seed will have abundant water. "Their king will be greater than Agag; their kingdom will be exalted. **8** "God brought them out of Egypt; they have the strength of a wild ox. They devour hostile nations and break their bones in pieces; with their arrows they pierce them. **9** Like a lion they crouch and lie down, like a lioness—who dares to rouse them? "May those who bless you be blessed and those who curse you be cursed!" - (NIV84)

Wednesday Isaiah 44:1 "But now listen, O Jacob, my servant, Israel, whom I have chosen. **2** This is what the Lord says—he who made you, who formed you in the womb, and who will help you: Do not be afraid, O Jacob, my servant, Jeshurun, whom I have chosen. **3** For I will pour water on the thirsty land, and streams on the dry ground; I will pour out my Spirit on your offspring, and my blessing on your descendants. **4** They will spring up like grass in a meadow, like poplar trees by flowing streams. - (NIV84)

Thursday: Genesis 41:37 The plan seemed good to Pharaoh and to all his officials. **38** So Pharaoh asked them, "Can we find anyone like this man, one in whom is the spirit of God?" **39** Then Pharaoh said to Joseph, "Since God has made all this known to you, there is no one so discerning and wise as you. **40** You shall be in charge of my palace, and all my people are to submit to your orders. Only with respect to the throne will I be greater than you." **41** So Pharaoh said to Joseph, "I hereby put you in charge of the whole land of Egypt." **42** Then Pharaoh took his signet ring from his finger and put it on Joseph's finger. He dressed him in robes of fine linen and put a gold chain around his neck. **43** He had him ride in a chariot as his second-in-command, and men shouted before him, "Make way!" Thus he put him in charge of the whole land of Egypt. - (NIV84)

Friday: 2 Samuel 23:1 These are the last words of David: "The oracle of David son of Jesse, the oracle of the man exalted by the Most High, the man anointed by the God of Jacob, Israel's singer of songs: **2** "The Spirit of the Lord spoke through me; his word was on my tongue. **3** The God of Israel spoke, the Rock of Israel said to me: 'When one rules over men in righteousness, when he rules in the fear of God, **4** he is like the light of morning at sunrise on a cloudless morning, like the brightness after rain that brings the grass from the earth.' **5** "Is not my house right with God? Has he not made with me an everlasting covenant, arranged and secured in every part? Will he not bring to fruition my salvation and grant me my every desire? - (NIV84)

Saturday: 2 Chronicles 20:14 Then the Spirit of the Lord came upon Jahaziel son of Zechariah, the son of Benaiah, the son of Jeiel, the son of Mattaniah, a Levite and descendant of Asaph, as he stood in the assembly. **15** He said: "Listen, King Jehoshaphat and all who live in Judah and Jerusalem! This is what the Lord says to you: 'Do not be afraid or discouraged because of this vast army. For the battle is not yours, but God's. **16** Tomorrow march down against them. They will be climbing up by the Pass of Ziz, and you will find them at the end of the gorge in the Desert of Jeruel. **17** You will not have to fight this battle. Take up your positions; stand firm and see the deliverance the Lord will give you, O Judah and Jerusalem. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged. Go out to face them tomorrow, and the Lord will be with you.' " **18** Jehoshaphat bowed with his face to the ground, and all the people of Judah and Jerusalem fell down in worship before the Lord. **19** Then some Levites from the Kohathites and Korahites stood up and praised the Lord, the God of Israel, with very loud voice. - (NIV84)
