YOUR SCRIPTURE FOR THE DAY

Monday: 1 Chronicles 22:7 David said to Solomon: "My son, I had it in my heart to build a house for the Name of the Lord my God. **8** But this word of the Lord came to me: 'You have shed much blood and have fought many wars. You are not to build a house for my Name, because you have shed much blood on the earth in my sight. **9** But you will have a son who will be a man of peace and rest, and I will give him rest from all his enemies on every side. His name will be Solomon, and I will grant Israel peace and quiet during his reign. **10** He is the one who will build a house for my Name. He will be my son, and I will be his father. And I will establish the throne of his kingdom over Israel forever.' - (NIV)

Tuesday Isaiah 9:6 For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. **7** Of the greatness of his government and peace there will be no end. He will reign on David's throne and over his kingdom, establishing and upholding it with justice and righteousness from that time on and forever. The zeal of the Lord Almighty will accomplish this. - (NIV)

James 3:17 But the wisdom that comes from heaven is first of all pure; then peace-loving, considerate, submissive, full of mercy and good fruit, impartial and sincere. **18** Peacemakers who sow in peace raise a harvest of righteousness. - (NIV84)

Wednesday Ephesians 2:14 For he himself is our peace, who has made the two one and has destroyed the barrier, the dividing wall of hostility, **15** by abolishing in his flesh the law with its commandments and regulations. His purpose was to create in himself one new man out of the two, thus making peace, **16** and in this one body to reconcile both of them to God through the cross, by which he put to death their hostility. **17** He came and preached peace to you who were far away and peace to those who were near. **18** For through him we both have access to the Father by one Spirit. - (NIV84)

Philippians 4:6 Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. **7** And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. - (NIV84)

Thursday: John 20:19 On the evening of that first day of the week, when the disciples were together, with the doors locked for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood among them and said, "**Peace be with you!**" **20** After he said this, he showed them his hands and side. The disciples were overjoyed when they saw the Lord. **21** Again Jesus said, "**Peace be with you! As the Father has sent me, I am sending you.**" **22** And with that he breathed on them and said, "**Receive the Holy Spirit. 23 If you forgive anyone his sins, they are forgiven; if you do not forgive them, they are not forgiven.**" - (NIV84)

Friday: Psalms 85:8 I will listen to what God the Lord will say; he promises peace to his people, his saints— but let them not return to folly. **9** Surely his salvation is near those who fear him, that his glory may dwell in our land. **10** Love and faithfulness meet together; righteousness and peace kiss each other. **11** Faithfulness springs forth from the earth, and righteousness looks down from heaven. - (NIV84)

Psalms 37:35 I have seen a wicked and ruthless man flourishing like a green tree in its native soil, **36** but he soon passed away and was no more; though I looked for him, he could not be found. **37** Consider the blameless, observe the upright; there is a future for the man of peace. - (NIV84)

Saturday: Hebrews 12:11 No discipline seems pleasant at the time, but painful. Later on, however, it produces a harvest of righteousness and peace for those who have been trained by it. **12** Therefore, strengthen your feeble arms and weak knees. **13** "Make level paths for your feet," so that the lame may not be disabled, but rather healed. **14** Make every effort to live in peace with all men and to be holy; without holiness no one will see the Lord. - (NIV84)
