**YOUR SCRIPTURE FOR THE DAY**

**Monday: James 5:7** Be patient, then, brothers, until the Lord's coming. See how the farmer waits for the land to yield its valuable crop and how patient he is for the autumn and spring rains. **8** You too, be patient and stand firm, because the Lord's coming is near. **9** Don't grumble against each other, brothers, or you will be judged. The Judge is standing at the door! **10** Brothers, as an example of patience in the face of suffering, take the prophets who spoke in the name of the Lord. **11** As you know, we consider blessed those who have persevered. You have heard of Job's perseverance and have seen what the Lord finally brought about. The Lord is full of compassion and mercy. - (NIV84)

**2 Peter 3:15** Bear in mind that our Lord's patience means salvation, just as our dear brother Paul also wrote you with the wisdom that God gave him. - (NIV84)

**Tuesday Titus 3:4** But—When God our Savior revealed his kindness and love, **5** he saved us, not because of the righteous things we had done, but because of his mercy. He washed away our sins, giving us a new birth and new life through the Holy Spirit. **6** He generously poured out the Spirit upon us through Jesus Christ our Savior. **7** Because of his grace he made us right in his sight and gave us confidence that we will inherit eternal life. - (NLT)

**Colossians 3:12** Since God chose you to be the holy people he loves, you must clothe yourselves with tenderhearted mercy, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience. - (NLT)

**Wednesday 2 Corinthians 6:4** In everything we do, we show that we are true ministers of God. We patiently endure troubles and hardships and calamities of every kind. **5** We have been beaten, been put in prison, faced angry mobs, worked to exhaustion, endured sleepless nights, and gone without food. **6** We prove ourselves by our purity, our understanding, our patience, our kindness, by the Holy Spirit within us, and by our sincere love. **7** We faithfully preach the truth. God's power is working in us. We use the weapons of righteousness in the right hand for attack and the left hand for defense. - (NLT)

**Thursday: 2 Peter 1:3** His divine power has given us everything we need for life and godliness through our knowledge of him who called us by his own glory and goodness. **4** Through these he has given us his very great and precious promises, so that through them you may participate in the divine nature and escape the corruption in the world caused by evil desires. **5** For this very reason, make every effort to add to your faith goodness; and to goodness, knowledge; **6** and to knowledge, self-control; and to self-control, perseverance; and to perseverance, godliness; **7** and to godliness, brotherly kindness; and to brotherly kindness, love. **8** For if you possess these qualities in increasing measure, they will keep you from being ineffective and unproductive in your knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. - (NIV84)

**Friday: Exodus 33:18** Then Moses said, "Now show me your glory." **19** And the Lord said, "I will cause all my goodness to pass in front of you, and I will proclaim my name, the Lord, in your presence. I will have mercy on whom I will have mercy, and I will have compassion on whom I will have compassion. **20** But," he said, "you cannot see my face, for no one may see me and live." **21** Then the Lord said, "There is a place near me where you may stand on a rock. **22** When my glory passes by, I will put you in a cleft in the rock and cover you with my hand until I have passed by. **23** Then I will remove my hand and you will see my back; but my face must not be seen." - (NIV84)

**Saturday: Luke 18:18** A certain ruler asked him, "Good teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?" **19** "Why do you call me good?" Jesus answered. "No one is good—except God alone. **20** You know the commandments: 'Do not commit adultery, do not murder, do not steal, do not give false testimony, honor your father and mother.'" **21** "All these I have kept since I was a boy," he said. **22** When Jesus heard this, he said to him, "You still lack one thing. Sell everything you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven. Then come, follow me." **23** When he heard this, he became very sad, because he was a man of great wealth. - (NIV84)
