## YOUR SCRIPTURE FOR THE DAY

**Monday: Ephesians 4:29** Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen. **30** And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, with whom you were sealed for the day of redemption. **31** Get rid of all bitterness, rage and anger, brawling and slander, along with every form of malice. **32** Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you. - (NIV84)

**Tuesday John 6:26** Jesus answered, "I tell you the truth, you are looking for me, not because you saw miraculous signs but because you ate the loaves and had your fill. **27** Do not work for food that spoils, but for food that endures to eternal life, which the Son of Man will give you. On him God the Father has placed his seal of approval." - (NIV84)

**2 Corinthians 5:4** For while we are in this tent, we groan and are burdened, because we do not wish to be unclothed but to be clothed with our heavenly dwelling, so that what is mortal may be swallowed up by life. **5** Now it is God who has made us for this very purpose and has given us the Spirit as a deposit, guaranteeing what is to come. - (NIV84)

**Wednesday Exodus 28:36** "Make a plate of pure gold and engrave on it as on a seal: holy to the Lord. **37** Fasten a blue cord to it to attach it to the turban; it is to be on the front of the turban. **38** It will be on Aaron's forehead, and he will bear the guilt involved in the sacred gifts the Israelites consecrate, whatever their gifts may be. It will be on Aaron's forehead continually so that they will be acceptable to the Lord. - (NIV84)

**2 Corinthians 3:3** You show that you are a letter from Christ, the result of our ministry, written not with ink but with the Spirit of the living God, not on tablets of stone but on tablets of human hearts. - (NIV84)

**Thursday: 2 Corinthians 3:7** Now if the ministry that brought death, which was engraved in letters on stone, came with glory, so that the Israelites could not look steadily at the face of Moses because of its glory, fading though it was, **8** will not the ministry of the Spirit be even more glorious? **9** If the ministry that condemns men is glorious, how much more glorious is the ministry that brings righteousness! **10** For what was glorious has no glory now in comparison with the surpassing glory. **11** And if what was fading away came with glory, how much greater is the glory of that which lasts! - (NIV84)

**Friday: 2 Corinthians 3:12** Therefore, since we have such a hope, we are very bold. **13** We are not like Moses, who would put a veil over his face to keep the Israelites from gazing at it while the radiance was fading away. **14** But their minds were made dull, for to this day the same veil remains when the old covenant is read. It has not been removed, because only in Christ is it taken away. **15** Even to this day when Moses is read, a veil covers their hearts. **16** But whenever anyone turns to the Lord, the veil is taken away. **17** Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom. **18** And we, who with unveiled faces all reflect the Lord's glory, are being transformed into his likeness with ever-increasing glory, which comes from the Lord, who is the Spirit. - (NIV84)

**Saturday: Jeremiah 32:8** "Then, just as the Lord had said, my cousin Hanamel came to me in the courtyard of the guard and said, 'Buy my field at Anathoth in the territory of Benjamin. Since it is your right to redeem it and possess it, buy it for yourself.' "I knew that this was the word of the Lord; **9** so I bought the field at Anathoth from my cousin Hanamel and weighed out for him seventeen shekels of silver. **10** I signed and sealed the deed, had it witnessed, and weighed out the silver on the scales. **11** I took the deed of purchase—the sealed copy containing the terms and conditions, as well as the unsealed copy— **12** and I gave this deed to Baruch son of Neriah, the son of Mahseiah, in the presence of my cousin Hanamel and of the witnesses who had signed the deed and of all the Jews sitting in the courtyard of the guard. - (NIV84)
