**How God reveals the nature of the Holy Spirit (6)**

1. Like a dove the Holy Spirit comes gentle & in peace
2. The dove rested on Jesus and desires to rest on us
3. The dove symbolizes innocence, gentleness & rest
4. Doves symbolize sacrifice & purification for people
5. The dove shows the way out of judgment into safety

## YOUR SCRIPTURE FOR THE DAY

**Monday: John 1:29** The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him and said, "Look, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world! **30** This is the one I meant when I said, 'A man who comes after me has surpassed me because he was before me.' **31** I myself did not know him, but the reason I came baptizing with water was that he might be revealed to Israel." **32** Then John gave this testimony: "I saw the Spirit come down from heaven as a dove and remain on him. **33** I would not have known him, except that the one who sent me to baptize with water told me, 'The man on whom you see the Spirit come down and remain is he who will baptize with the Holy Spirit.' **34** I have seen and I testify that this is the Son of God." - (NIV84)

**Tuesday Luke 3:21** When all the people were being baptized, Jesus was baptized too. And as he was praying, heaven was opened **22** and the Holy Spirit descended on him in bodily form like a dove. And a voice came from heaven: "You are my Son, whom I love; with you I am well pleased." - (NIV84)

**Matthew 10:16** I am sending you out like sheep among wolves. Therefore be as shrewd as snakes and as innocent as doves. - (NIV84)

**Wednesday Genesis 8:1** But God remembered Noah and all the wild animals and the livestock that were with him in the ark, and he sent a wind over the earth, and the waters receded. **2** Now the springs of the deep and the floodgates of the heavens had been closed, and the rain had stopped falling from the sky. **3** The water receded steadily from the earth. At the end of the hundred and fifty days the water had gone down, **4** and on the seventeenth day of the seventh month the ark came to rest on the mountains of Ararat. **5** The waters continued to recede until the tenth month, and on the first day of the tenth month the tops of the mountains became visible. **6** After forty days Noah opened the window he had made in the ark **7** and sent out a raven, and it kept flying back and forth until the water had dried up from the earth. **8** Then he sent out a dove to see if the water had receded from the surface of the ground. **9** But the dove could find no place to set its feet because there was water over all the surface of the earth; so it returned to Noah in the ark. He reached out his hand and took the dove and brought it back to himself in the ark. **10** He waited seven more days and again sent out the dove from the ark. **11** When the dove returned to him in the evening, there in its beak was a freshly plucked olive leaf! Then Noah knew that the water had receded from the earth. **12** He waited seven more days and sent the dove out again, but this time it did not return to him. - (NIV84)

**Thursday: Psalms 55:4** My heart is in anguish within me; the terrors of death assail me. **5** Fear and trembling have beset me; horror has overwhelmed me. **6** I said, "Oh, that I had the wings of a dove! I would fly away and be at rest— **7** I would flee far away and stay in the desert; Selah **8** I would hurry to my place of shelter, far from the tempest and storm." - (NIV84)

**Romans 8:26** In the same way, the Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray for, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us with groans that words cannot express. - (NIV84)

**Friday: Luke 2:22** When the time of their purification according to the Law of Moses had been completed, Joseph and Mary took him to Jerusalem to present him to the Lord **23** (as it is written in the Law of the Lord, "Every firstborn male is to be consecrated to the Lord"), **24** and to offer a sacrifice in keeping with what is said in the Law of the Lord: "a pair of doves or two young pigeons." - (NIV84)

**Saturday: Numbers 6:9** "If someone dies suddenly in his presence, thus defiling the hair he has dedicated, he must shave his head on the day of his cleansing—the seventh day. **10** Then on the eighth day he must bring two doves or two young pigeons to the priest at the entrance to the Tent of Meeting. - (NIV84)

**Genesis 15:9** So the Lord said to him, "Bring me a heifer, a goat and a ram, each three years old, along with a dove and a young pigeon." - (NIV84)
