YOUR SCRIPTURE FOR THE DAY

Monday: Hosea 14:1 Return, O Israel, to the Lord your God. Your sins have been your downfall! **2** Take words with you and return to the Lord. Say to him: "Forgive all our sins and receive us graciously, that we may offer the fruit of our lips. **3** Assyria cannot save us; we will not mount war-horses. We will never again say 'Our gods' to what our own hands have made, for in you the fatherless find compassion." **4** "I will heal their waywardness and love them freely, for my anger has turned away from them. **5** I will be like the dew to Israel; he will blossom like a lily. Like a cedar of Lebanon he will send down his roots; **6** his young shoots will grow. His splendor will be like an olive tree, his fragrance like a cedar of Lebanon. - (NIV84)

Tuesday Genesis 27:26 Then his father Isaac said to him, "Come here, my son, and kiss me." **27** So he went to him and kissed him. When Isaac caught the smell of his clothes, he blessed him and said, "Ah, the smell of my son is like the smell of a field that the Lord has blessed. **28** May God give you of heaven's dew and of earth's richness— an abundance of grain and new wine. - (NIV84)

Numbers 11:9 The manna came down on the camp with the dew during the night. - (NLT)

Wednesday Exodus 16:11 Then the Lord said to Moses, **12** "I have heard the Israelites' complaints. Now tell them, 'In the evening you will have meat to eat, and in the morning you will have all the bread you want. Then you will know that I am the Lord your God.'" **13** That evening vast numbers of quail flew in and covered the camp. And the next morning the area around the camp was wet with dew. **14** When the dew evaporated, a flaky substance as fine as frost blanketed the ground. **15** The Israelites were puzzled when they saw it. "What is it?" they asked each other. They had no idea what it was. And Moses told them, "It is the food the Lord has given you to eat. - (NLT)

Thursday: Deuteronomy 33:27 The eternal God is your refuge, and his everlasting arms are under you. He drives out the enemy before you; he cries out, 'Destroy them!' **28** So Israel will live in safety, prosperous Jacob in security, in a land of grain and new wine, while the heavens drop down dew. - (NLT)

Zechariah 8:12 For I am planting seeds of peace and prosperity among you. The grapevines will be heavy with fruit. The earth will produce its crops, and the heavens will release the dew. Once more I will cause the remnant in Judah and Israel to inherit these blessings. - (NLT)

Friday: Judges 6:36 Then Gideon said to God, "If you are truly going to use me to rescue Israel as you promised, **37** prove it to me in this way. I will put a wool fleece on the threshing floor tonight. If the fleece is wet with dew in the morning but the ground is dry, then I will know that you are going to help me rescue Israel as you promised." **38** And that is just what happened. When Gideon got up early the next morning, he squeezed the fleece and wrung out a whole bowlful of water. **39** Then Gideon said to God, "Please don't be angry with me, but let me make one more request. Let me use the fleece for one more test. This time let the fleece remain dry while the ground around it is wet with dew." **40** So that night God did as Gideon asked. The fleece was dry in the morning, but the ground was covered with dew. - (NLT)

Saturday: Isaiah 18:4 For the Lord has told me this: "I will watch quietly from my dwelling place— as quietly as the heat rises on a summer day, or as the morning dew forms during the harvest." - (NLT)

Isaiah 26:19 But those who die in the Lord will live; their bodies will rise again! Those who sleep in the earth will rise up and sing for joy! For your life-giving light will fall like dew on your people in the place of the dead! - (NLT)
