Your Scripture for the Day

Monday: Psalms 2:1 Why do the nations conspire and the peoples plot in vain? **2** The kings of the earth take their stand and the rulers gather together against the Lord and against his Anointed One. **3** "Let us break their chains," they say, "and throw off their fetters." **4** The One enthroned in heaven laughs; the Lord scoffs at them. **5** Then he rebukes them in his anger and terrifies them in his wrath, saying, **6** "I have installed my King on Zion, my holy hill." **7** I will proclaim the decree of the Lord: He said to me, "You are my Son; today I have become your Father. **8** Ask of me, and I will make the nations your inheritance, the ends of the earth your possession. - (NIV84)

Tuesday Psalms 37 Of David. **1** Do not fret because of evil men or be envious of those who do wrong; **2** for like the grass they will soon wither, like green plants they will soon die away. **3** Trust in the Lord and do good; dwell in the land and enjoy safe pasture. **4** Delight yourself in the Lord and he will give you the desires of your heart. **5** Commit your way to the Lord; trust in him and he will do this: **6** He will make your righteousness shine like the dawn, the justice of your cause like the noonday sun. **7** Be still before the Lord and wait patiently for him; do not fret when men succeed in their ways, when they carry out their wicked schemes. **8** Refrain from anger and turn from wrath; do not fret—it leads only to evil. **9** For evil men will be cut off, but those who hope in the Lord will inherit the land. - (NIV84)

Wednesday 1 Corinthians 1:25 For the foolishness of God is wiser than man's wisdom, and the weakness of God is stronger than man's strength. **26** Brothers, think of what you were when you were called. Not many of you were wise by human standards; not many were influential; not many were of noble birth. **27** But God chose the foolish things of the world to shame the wise; God chose the weak things of the world to shame the strong. - (NIV84)

Psalms 104:24 How many are your works, O Lord! In wisdom you made them all; the earth is full of your creatures. - (NIV84)

Proverbs 15:3 The eyes of the Lord are everywhere, keeping watch on the wicked and the good. - (NIV84)

Thursday: Jeremiah 23:23 "Am I only a God nearby," declares the Lord, "and not a God far away?" **24** Can anyone hide in secret places so that I cannot see him?" declares the Lord. "Do not I fill heaven and earth?" declares the Lord. **25** "I have heard what the prophets say who prophesy lies in my name. They say, 'I had a dream! I had a dream!' **26** How long will this continue in the hearts of these lying prophets, who prophesy the delusions of their own minds? **27** They think the dreams they tell one another will make my people forget my name, just as their fathers forgot my name through Baal worship. **28** Let the prophet who has a dream tell his dream, but let the one who has my word speak it faithfully. For what has straw to do with grain?" declares the Lord. **29** "Is not my word like fire," declares the Lord, "and like a hammer that breaks a rock in pieces?" - (NIV84)

Friday: Psalms 139:1 O Lord, you have searched me and you know me. **2** You know when I sit and when I rise; you perceive my thoughts from afar. **3** You discern my going out and my lying down; you are familiar with all my ways. **4** Before a word is on my tongue you know it completely, O Lord. **5** You hem me in—behind and before; you have laid your hand upon me. **6** Such knowledge is too wonderful for me, too lofty for me to attain. **7** Where can I go from your Spirit? Where can I flee from your presence? **8** If I go up to the heavens, you are there; if I make my bed in the depths, you are there. **9** If I rise on the wings of the dawn, if I settle on the far side of the sea, **10** even there your hand will guide me, your right hand will hold me fast. - (NIV84)

Saturday: Isaiah 29:15 Woe to those who go to great depths to hide their plans from the Lord, who do their work in darkness and think, "Who sees us? Who will know?" **16** You turn things upside down, as if the potter were thought to be like the clay! Shall what is formed say to him who formed it, "He did not make me"? Can the pot say of the potter, "He knows nothing"? - (NIV84)
