Your Scripture for the Day

Monday: Revelation 13:8 All inhabitants of the earth will worship the beast - all whose names have not been written in the book of life belonging to the Lamb that was slain from the creation of the world. - (NIV84)

Ephesians 1:4 For he chose us in him before the creation of the world to be holy and blameless in his sight. In love **5** he predestined us to be adopted as his sons through Jesus Christ, in accordance with his pleasure and will— **6** to the praise of his glorious grace, which he has freely given us in the One he loves. - (NIV84)

Tuesday Galatians 4:4 But when the time had fully come, God sent his Son, born of a woman, born under law, **5** to redeem those under law, that we might receive the full rights of sons. - (NIV84)

Thursday: Hebrews 4:3 Now we who have believed enter that rest, just as God has said, "So I declared on oath in my anger, 'They shall never enter my rest.'" And yet his work has been finished since the creation of the world. **4** For somewhere he has spoken about the seventh day in these words: "And on the seventh day God rested from all his work." **5** And again in the passage above he says, "They shall never enter my rest." **6** It still remains that some will enter that rest, and those who formerly had the gospel preached to them did not go in, because of their disobedience. - (NIV84)

Friday: Isaiah 66:1 This is what the Lord says: "Heaven is my throne, and the earth is my footstool. Where is the house you will build for me? Where will my resting place be? **2** Has not my hand made all these things, and so they came into being?" declares the Lord. "This is the one I esteem: he who is humble and contrite in spirit, and trembles at my word. - (NIV84)
