**Your Scripture for the Day**

**Monday: Revelation 14:1** Then I looked, and there before me was the Lamb, standing on Mount Zion, and with him 144,000 who had his name and his Father's name written on their foreheads. **2** And I heard a sound from heaven like the roar of rushing waters and like a loud peal of thunder. The sound I heard was like that of harpists playing their harps. **3** And they sang a new song before the throne and before the four living creatures and the elders. No one could learn the song except the 144,000 who had been redeemed from the earth. **4** These are those who did not defile themselves with women, for they kept themselves pure. They follow the Lamb wherever he goes. They were purchased from among men and offered as firstfruits to God and the Lamb. - (NIV84)

**Tuesday Psalms 149:1** Praise the Lord. Sing to the Lord a new song, his praise in the assembly of the saints. **2** Let Israel rejoice in their Maker; let the people of Zion be glad in their King. **3** Let them praise his name with dancing and make music to him with tambourine and harp. **4** For the Lord takes delight in his people; he crowns the humble with salvation. **5** Let the saints rejoice in this honor and sing for joy on their beds. - (NIV84)

**Psalms 47:5** God has ascended amid shouts of joy, the Lord amid the sounding of trumpets. **6** Sing praises to God, sing praises; sing praises to our King, sing praises. **7** For God is the King of all the earth; sing to him a psalm of praise. **8** God reigns over the nations; God is seated on his holy throne. **9** The nobles of the nations assemble as the people of the God of Abraham, for the kings of the earth belong to God; he is greatly exalted. - (NIV84)

**Wednesday Isaiah 42:10** Sing to the Lord a new song, his praise from the ends of the earth, you who go down to the sea, and all that is in it, you islands, and all who live in them. **11** Let the desert and its towns raise their voices; let the settlements where Kedar lives rejoice. Let the people of Sela sing for joy; let them shout from the mountaintops. **12** Let them give glory to the Lord and proclaim his praise in the islands. **13** The Lord will march out like a mighty man, like a warrior he will stir up his zeal; with a shout he will raise the battle cry and will triumph over his enemies. - (NIV84)

**Thursday: Revelation 19:5** Then a voice came from the throne, saying: "Praise our God, all you his servants, you who fear him, both small and great!" **6** Then I heard what sounded like a great multitude, like the roar of rushing waters and like loud peals of thunder, shouting: "Hallelujah! For our Lord God Almighty reigns. **7** Let us rejoice and be glad and give him glory! For the wedding of the Lamb has come, and his bride has made herself ready. **8** Fine linen, bright and clean, was given her to wear." (Fine linen stands for the righteous acts of the saints.) - (NIV84)

**Friday: Psalms 89:5** The heavens praise your wonders, O Lord, your faithfulness too, in the assembly of the holy ones. **6** For who in the skies above can compare with the Lord? Who is like the Lord among the heavenly beings? **7** In the council of the holy ones God is greatly feared; he is more awesome than all who surround him. **8** O Lord God Almighty, who is like you? You are mighty, O Lord, and your faithfulness surrounds you. - (NIV84)

**Psalms 33:1** Sing joyfully to the Lord, you righteous; it is fitting for the upright to praise him. **2** Praise the Lord with the harp; make music to him on the ten-stringed lyre. **3** Sing to him a new song; play skillfully, and shout for joy. - (NIV84)

**Saturday: Psalms 2:1** Why do the nations conspire and the peoples plot in vain? **2** The kings of the earth take their stand and the rulers gather together against the LORD and against his Anointed One. **3** "Let us break their chains," they say, "and throw off their fetters." **4** The One enthroned in heaven laughs; the Lord scoffs at them. **5** Then he rebukes them in his anger and terrifies them in his wrath, saying, **6** "I have installed my King on Zion, my holy hill." **7** I will proclaim the decree of the LORD: He said to me, "You are my Son; today I have become your Father. **8** Ask of me, and I will make the nations your inheritance, the ends of the earth your possession. **9** You will rule them with an iron scepter; you will dash them to pieces like pottery." **10** Therefore, you kings, be wise; be warned, you rulers of the earth. **11** Serve the LORD with fear and rejoice with trembling. **12** Kiss the Son, lest he be angry and you be destroyed in your way, for his wrath can flare up in a moment. Blessed are all who take refuge in him. - (NIV84)
