Your Scripture for the Day

Monday: Isaiah 61:1 The Spirit of the Sovereign Lord is on me, because the Lord has anointed me to preach good news to the poor. He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim freedom for the captives and release from darkness for the prisoners, **2** to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor and the day of vengeance of our God, to comfort all who mourn, **3** and provide for those who grieve in Zion—to bestow on them a crown of beauty instead of ashes, the oil of gladness instead of mourning, and a garment of praise instead of a spirit of despair. They will be called oaks of righteousness, a planting of the Lord for the display of his splendor. **4** They will rebuild the ancient ruins and restore the places long devastated; they will renew the ruined cities that have been devastated for generations. - (NIV84)

Tuesday Acts 3:17 "Friends, I realize that what you and your leaders did to Jesus was done in ignorance. **18** But God was fulfilling what all the prophets had foretold about the Messiah—that he must suffer these things. **19** Now repent of your sins and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped away. **20** Then times of refreshment will come from the presence of the Lord, and he will again send you Jesus, your appointed Messiah. **21** For he must remain in heaven until the time for the final restoration of all things, as God promised long ago through his holy prophets. - (NLT)

2 Corinthians 13:11 Finally, brothers, good-by. Aim for perfection, listen to my appeal, be of one mind, live in peace. And the God of love and peace will be with you. - (NIV84)

Wednesday Nehemiah 2:4 The king said to me, "What is it you want?" Then I prayed to the God of heaven, **5** and I answered the king, "If it pleases the king and if your servant has found favor in his sight, let him send me to the city in Judah where my fathers are buried so that I can rebuild it." - (NIV84)

Nehemiah 2:11 I went to Jerusalem, and after staying there three days **12** I set out during the night with a few men. I had not told anyone what my God had put in my heart to do for Jerusalem. There were no mounts with me except the one I was riding on. - (NIV84)

Thursday: Nehemiah 2:17 Then I said to them, "You see the trouble we are in: Jerusalem lies in ruins, and its gates have been burned with fire. Come, let us rebuild the wall of Jerusalem, and we will no longer be in disgrace." **18** I also told them about the gracious hand of my God upon me and what the king had said to me. They replied, "Let us start rebuilding." So they began this good work. **19** But when Sanballat the Horonite, Tobiah the Ammonite official and Geshem the Arab heard about it, they mocked and ridiculed us. "What is this you are doing?" they asked. "Are you rebelling against the king?" **20** I answered them by saying, "The God of heaven will give us success. We his servants will start rebuilding, but as for you, you have no share in Jerusalem or any claim or historic right to it." - (NIV84)

Friday: Nehemiah 4:10 Then the people of Judah began to complain, "The workers are getting tired, and there is so much rubble to be moved. We will never be able to build the wall by ourselves." **11** Meanwhile, our enemies were saying, "Before they know what's happening, we will swoop down on them and kill them and end their work." - (NLT)

Hebrews 11:39 All these people earned a good reputation because of their faith, yet none of them received all that God had promised. **40** For God had something better in mind for us, so that they would not reach perfection without us. - (NLT)

Saturday: Ezra 5:1 Now Haggai the prophet and Zechariah the prophet, a descendant of Iddo, prophesied to the Jews in Judah and Jerusalem in the name of the God of Israel, who was over them. **2** Then Zerubbabel son of Shealtiel and Jeshua son of Jozadak set to work to rebuild the house of God in Jerusalem. And the prophets of God were with them, helping them. **3** At that time Tattenai, governor of Trans-Euphrates, and Shethar-Bozenai and their associates went to them and asked, "Who authorized you to rebuild this temple and restore this structure?" **4** They also asked, "What are the names of the men constructing this building?" **5** But the eye of their God was watching over the elders of the Jews, and they were not stopped until a report could go to Darius and his written reply be received. - (NIV84)
