**Your Scripture for the Day**

**Monday:** **Luke 24:35** Then the two from Emmaus told their story of how Jesus had appeared to them as they were walking along the road, and how they had recognized him as he was breaking the bread. **36** And just as they were telling about it, Jesus himself was suddenly standing there among them. "Peace be with you," he said. **37** But the whole group was startled and frightened, thinking they were seeing a ghost! **38** "Why are you frightened?" he asked. "Why are your hearts filled with doubt? **39** Look at my hands. Look at my feet. You can see that it's really me. Touch me and make sure that I am not a ghost, because ghosts don't have bodies, as you see that I do." **40** As he spoke, he showed them his hands and his feet. **41** Still they stood there in disbelief, filled with joy and wonder. Then he asked them, "Do you have anything here to eat?" **42** They gave him a piece of broiled fish, **43** and he ate it as they watched. - (NLT)

**Tuesday** **Luke 24:44** Then he said, "When I was with you before, I told you that everything written about me in the law of Moses and the prophets and in the Psalms must be fulfilled." **45** Then he opened their minds to understand the Scriptures. **46** And he said, "Yes, it was written long ago that the Messiah would suffer and die and rise from the dead on the third day. **47** It was also written that this message would be proclaimed in the authority of his name to all the nations, beginning in Jerusalem: 'There is forgiveness of sins for all who repent.' **48** You are witnesses of all these things. **49** "And now I will send the Holy Spirit, just as my Father promised. But stay here in the city until the Holy Spirit comes and fills you with power from heaven." - (NLT)

**Wednesday** **Luke 24:13** That same day two of Jesus' followers were walking to the village of Emmaus, seven miles from Jerusalem. **14** As they walked along they were talking about everything that had happened. **15** As they talked and discussed these things, Jesus himself suddenly came and began walking with them. **16** But God kept them from recognizing him. **17** He asked them, "What are you discussing so intently as you walk along?" They stopped short, sadness written across their faces. **18** Then one of them, Cleopas, replied, "You must be the only person in Jerusalem who hasn't heard about all the things that have happened there the last few days." **19** "What things?" Jesus asked. "The things that happened to Jesus, the man from Nazareth," they said. "He was a prophet who did powerful miracles, and he was a mighty teacher in the eyes of God and all the people. **20** But our leading priests and other religious leaders handed him over to be condemned to death, and they crucified him. **21** We had hoped he was the Messiah who had come to rescue Israel. This all happened three days ago. - (NLT)

**Thursday:** **Luke 24:25** Then Jesus said to them, "You foolish people! You find it so hard to believe all that the prophets wrote in the Scriptures. **26** Wasn't it clearly predicted that the Messiah would have to suffer all these things before entering his glory?" **27** Then Jesus took them through the writings of Moses and all the prophets, explaining from all the Scriptures the things concerning himself. **28** By this time they were nearing Emmaus and the end of their journey. Jesus acted as if he were going on, **29** but they begged him, "Stay the night with us, since it is getting late." So he went home with them. **30** As they sat down to eat, he took the bread and blessed it. Then he broke it and gave it to them. **31** Suddenly, their eyes were opened, and they recognized him. And at that moment he disappeared! **32** They said to each other, "Didn't our hearts burn within us as he talked with us on the road and explained the Scriptures to us?" - (NLT)

**Friday:** **Ephesians 1:11** Furthermore, because we are united with Christ, we have received an inheritance from God, for he chose us in advance, and he makes everything work out according to his plan. **12** God's purpose was that we Jews who were the first to trust in Christ would bring praise and glory to God. **13** And now you Gentiles have also heard the truth, the Good News that God saves you. And when you believed in Christ, he identified you as his own by giving you the Holy Spirit, whom he promised long ago. **14** The Spirit is God's guarantee that he will give us the inheritance he promised and that he has purchased us to be his own people. He did this so we would praise and glorify him. - (NLT)

**Saturday:** **John 2:18** But the Jewish leaders demanded, "What are you doing? If God gave you authority to do this, show us a miraculous sign to prove it." **19** "All right," Jesus replied. "Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up." **20** "What!" they exclaimed. "It has taken forty-six years to build this Temple, and you can rebuild it in three days?" **21** But when Jesus said "this temple," he meant his own body. **22** After he was raised from the dead, his disciples remembered he had said this, and they believed both the Scriptures and what Jesus had said. - (NLT)

**Luke 22:37** It is written: 'And he was numbered with the transgressors'; and I tell you that this must be fulfilled in me. Yes, what is written about me is reaching its fulfillment." - (NIV84)
